After stopping in this quaint village, the tour continues to the Ljuta River area. Here, you can take a leisurely walk through lush surroundings, visit old watermills, and

## WINE TOUR – PELJESAC

Visit Peljesac, one of Croatia's most renowned wine regions, and taste some of Croatia's best wines!

Peljesac, the country's second-largest peninsula, just a 50-minute drive west of Dubrovnik, is home to Plavac Mali, an indigenous red grape variety that produces some of Croatia's finest wines.

Your eight-hour wine adventure begins with a scenic drive along the coast. Before indulging in wine tasting, you'll have time to explore Ston, a charming fortified medieval town at the very start of the peninsula.

After free time in Ston, your journey continues through the Dalmatian landscapes on the way to the wineries. Traditional stone houses, olive groves, and vineyards unfold along the way - some set in small karst fields, others sprawled across gentle and steep slopes - offering a glimpse into the diversity of flavors awaiting you on this adventure.

Each winery you visit has its own unique story, and as you savor the local flavors, your hosts will share the deep connection between wine making and life on the peninsula.

*The vineyards of Dingac on Peljesac Peninsula are among the steepest in the world. The combination of sea, sun, and stone creates a unique microclimate that infuses these wines with a distinct flavor.*

*The region's winemakers even built a tunnel in the seventies to more easily transport grapes, highlighting their dedication to quality wine making.*

## STON & TRSTENO

Here, you'll discover some of Europe's longest defensive walls, which you can climb for spectacular views. Ston is also home to the ancient saltworks, where salt has been continuously harvested since the Middle Ages.

The area is renowned for its culinary delights, particularly the famed Mali Ston oysters, which, along with other fresh seafood, have made this region one of Croatia's true gastronomic gems. During the tour, you can enhance your experience with a unique fresh oyster tasting, available upon request and for an additional fee.

While Montenegro's coastline may not be long, it features one of the most spectacular landscapes in the region. The Bay of Kotor, where this tour takes you, is home to dramatic scenery reminiscent of a fjord.

One of the most stunning natural wonders of Bosnia and Herzegovina lies on the Trebizat River, not far from the Croatian border. Whether you want to take a leisurely walk and snap photos, relax with a drink, or even take a refreshing swim, the Kravica Waterfall is the perfect stop on the way to Mostar.

Mostar, Herzegovina's largest city, embodies the complexity of the region's history. It is a meeting point of civilizations, cultures, and religions. You'll have the opportunity to explore Mostar's historical core, which carefully preserves its Ottoman heritage. Beyond the famed Stari Most (Old Bridge), which gracefully arches over the emerald-green Neretva River, you'll discover the charming Crooked Bridge, historic towers, mosques with slender minarets, and the vibrant bazaar with old artisan shops - all contributing to a feeling of stepping into a different world, far from the heart of Europe.

No visit to Mostar is complete without tasting the local cuisine, deeply rooted in Turkish influence. To make the most of your visit, we recommend exploring Mostar with a local guide who can bring its stories to life.

# MEDJUGORJE

**Just a two-hour drive from Dubrovnik lies Medjugorje, one of Europe's most renowned Marian pilgrimage sites, which offers a perfect opportunity for a meaningful day trip!**

Medjugorje is a town in southern Bosnia and Herzegovina. Its story changed forever in June 1981 when six local children reported seeing an apparition of the Virgin Mary in a nearby hamlet. From that moment, life in Medjugorje has never been the same. Despite intense efforts by the former Yugoslav regime to suppress the phenomenon, pilgrims continued to arrive, undeterred by the oppression. What makes Medjugorje unique is the ongoing nature of the apparitions - some among the original visionaries claim to still experience them today.

On this tour, you'll have the chance to explore Medjugorje at your own pace, including a visit to St. James Church and Apparition Hill.

For those looking to enhance their experience, a stop at the stunning Kravica Waterfall can be added to the itinerary for an additional fee.

Medjugorje attracts millions of visitors each year. Since its first apparition in 1981, it has become a symbol of faith and spiritual reflection. Many pilgrims climb Apparition Hill, often barefoot, as an act of devotion, and countless visitors have described experiencing a deep sense of peace and renewal during their visit, regardless of their religious beliefs.

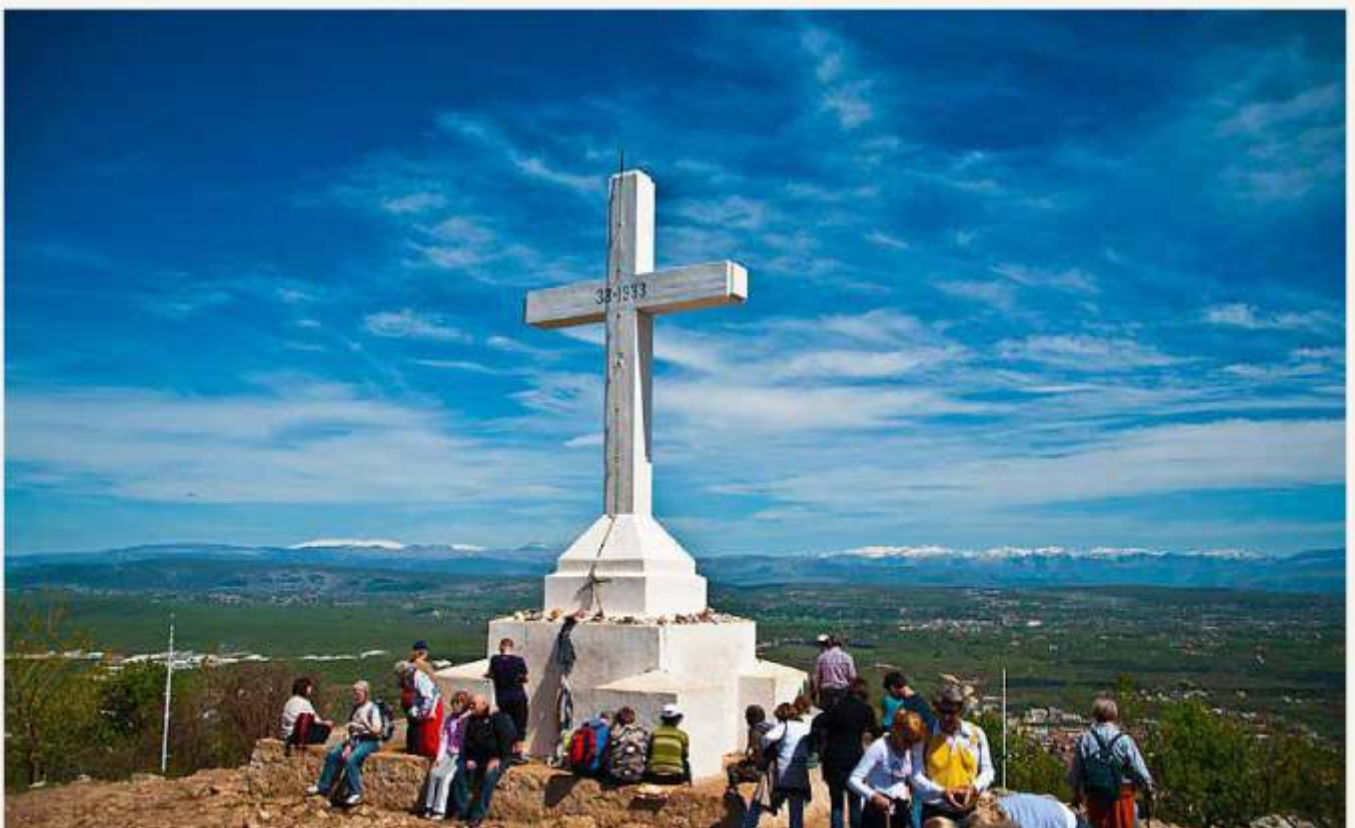
